UCSF's Research Analysis Environment (RAE), formerly MyResearch, is a secure data hosting and compute service for UCSF researchers and their internal or external collaborators.



Data Extracted From EMR

RAE must be used for all data extracted from EMR.

Purpose

RAE provides a collaborative workspace for multiple users that are listed and approved on your IRB. It also allows you to maintain one location for all files.

Secure PHI

This storage method allows our programmers to securely deliver your data, all while protecting our UCSF community's sensitive data that contains any of the 18 PHI.
